

GLEBE CENTRAL LITTLE LEAGUE – JANUARY 2011

Starting in the northwest corner, the boundary is described in a counter-clockwise direction, as:

1. Extending south along the existing railway track (which is the boundary between District 6 and District 2), continuing south to the Rideau River.
2. The southern boundary follows the Rideau River to the point where Highway 417 crosses the Rideau River. The southern boundary continues along Highway 417 in an easterly direction to the point where it crosses Green's Creek.
3. The eastern boundary is Green's Creek extending from Highway 417 to the Ottawa River.
4. The northern boundary is the Ottawa River.

Boundaries defined by roads should be interpreted such that GCLL membership eligibility includes families resident on both sides of the road, to avoid the unnecessary separation of players who are neighbours and friends.
