ORLEANS LITTLE LEAGUE - JANUARY 2011

Starting in the northwest corner, the boundary is described in a counter-clockwise direction, as:

- 1. From the convergence of Green's Creek and the Ottawa River, south along the Creek to the intersection with Highway 417, continuing south along Highway 417 to Exit 96 (Boundary Road).
- 2. The southern boundary extends from Highway 417 Exit 96 Boundary Road northeast on a direct line to the intersection of Russell and Milton Roads.
- 3. Then northeast on Regional Road 26 (Russell Road) to the intersection with Canaan Road.
- 4. Then northwest on Canaan Road (including a straight-line extension section in the middle) to the intersection with Highway 174 (Montreal Road) and then continuing on that line to the Ottawa River.
- 5. The northern boundary is formed by the Ottawa River.

Boundaries defined by roads should be interpreted such that OLLB membership eligibility includes families resident on both sides of the road, to avoid the unnecessary separation of players who are neighbours and friends.
